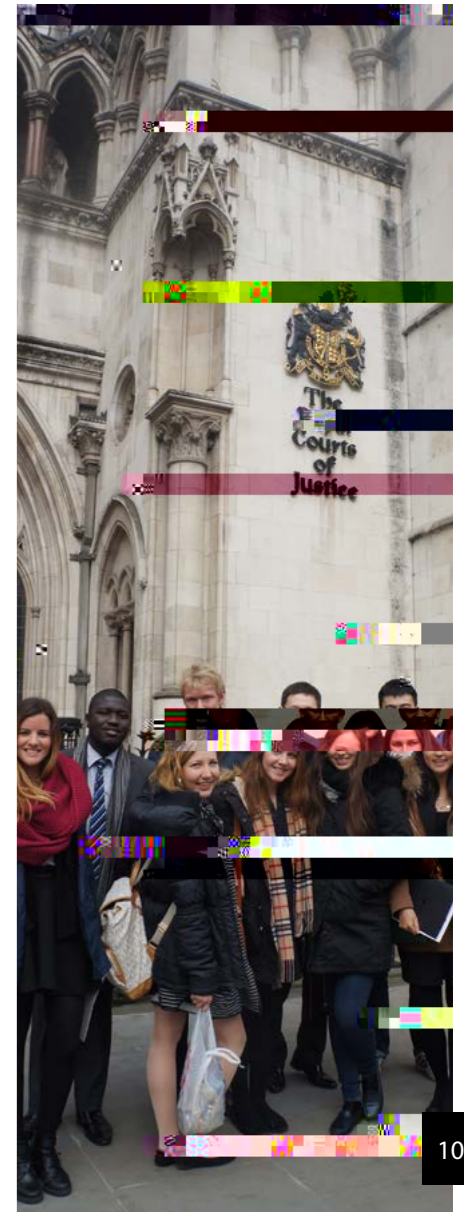
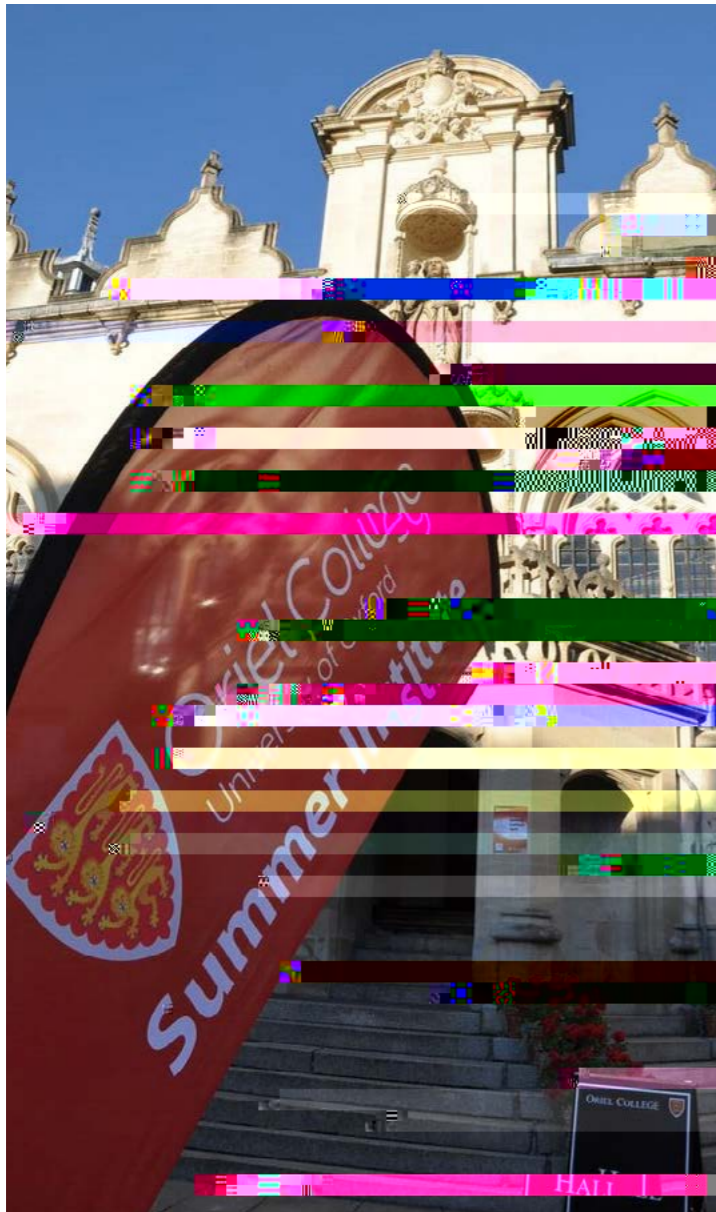
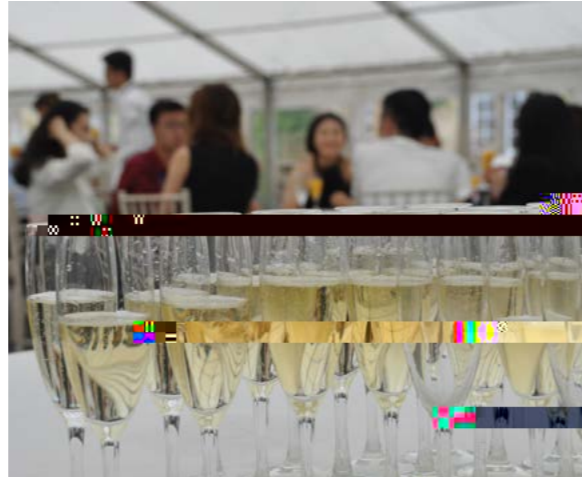
### *Queens of English Literature*

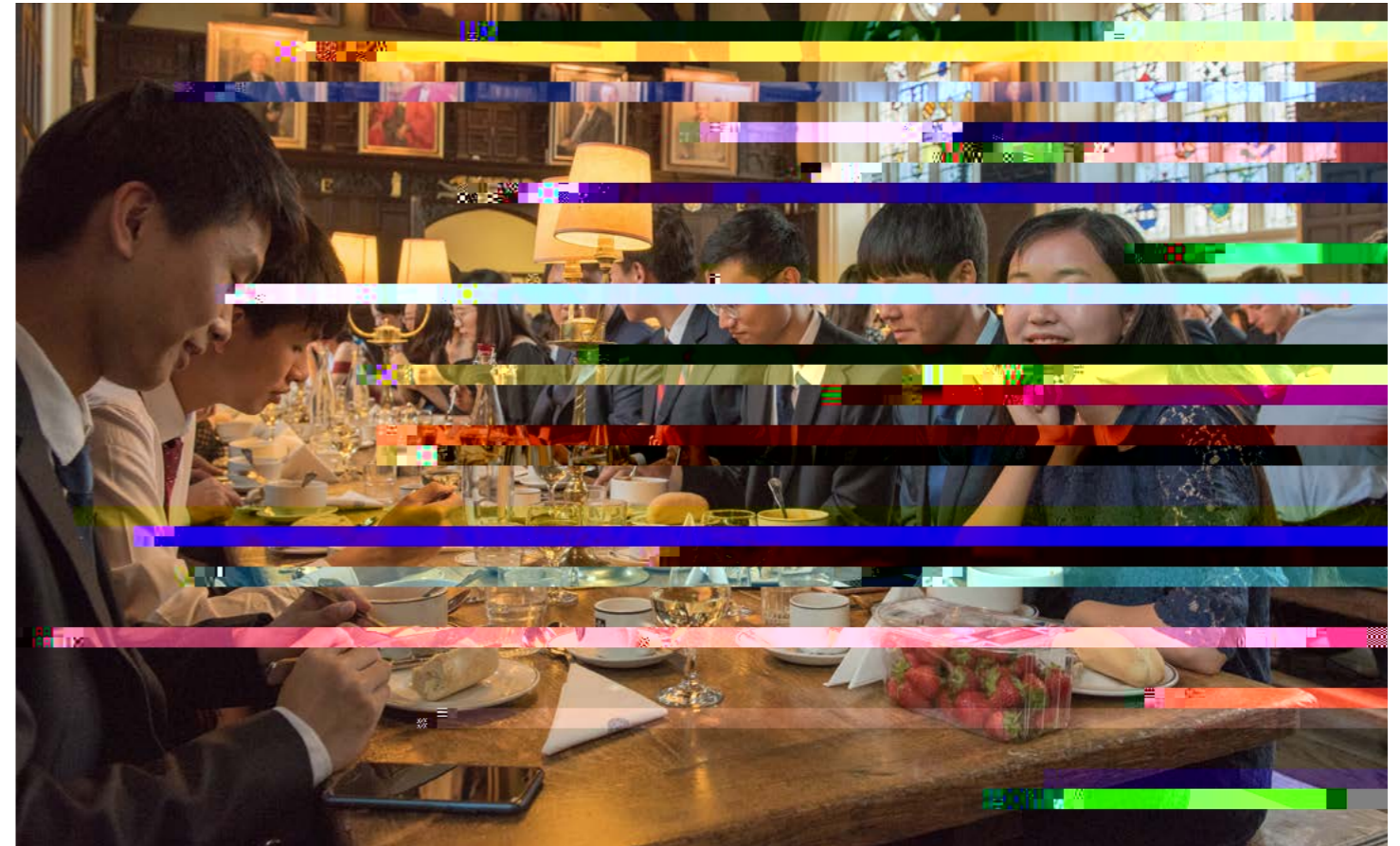

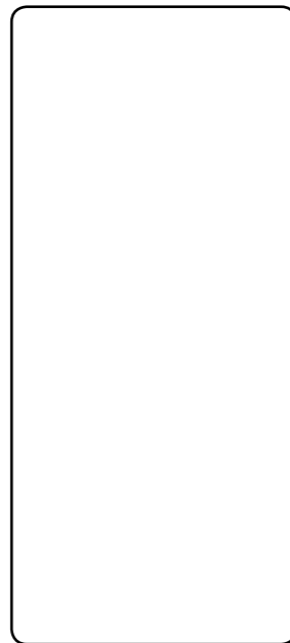
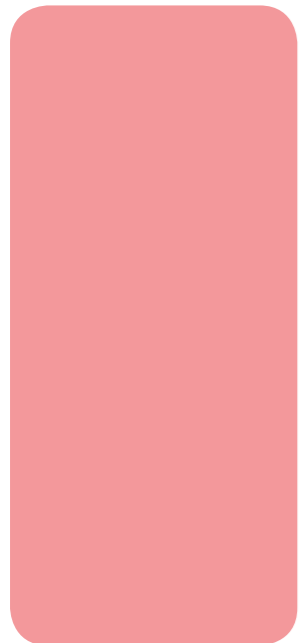
